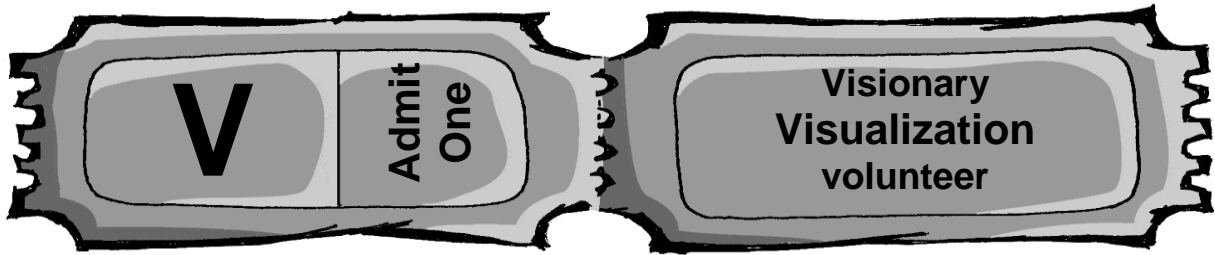


# BOOK CLUB – TICKET TO PARTICIPATE

**Role:** You are the visualization describer. Your role is to capture the visualizations (mental images you form in your mind while reading) on paper and encourage your Book Club to discuss your visualizations.

**JOB:** **BEFORE** **BOOK CLUB DISCUSSION**

1. Pay attention to the mental images you form as you read. Choose three things (people, places, events, objects, etc.) in the reading that you were able to clearly imagine or visualize.

2. In the table below, draw a small, colorful illustration ("Thumbnail Sketch") of each thing you visualized. Use colored pencils and give your best effort to make your drawings match your mental images. Then write a brief caption (title or description of the picture) under each drawing.

**DURING** **BOOK CLUB DISCUSSION**

1. Without showing your caption, show your drawing to your group members and encourage them to guess what you have drawn.

2. Read the caption and explain what you have drawn.
3. Encourage members of your Book Club to discuss your visualization and discuss how their visualizations of the people, places, events, objects, etc. were similar or different.
